The Vancouver Park Board hereby grants the permit holder and their representative's permission to use the facilities outlined subject to the TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT contained herein and attached hereto, all of which form part of this agreement. Accepting this permit from the Vancouver Park Board constitutes an acknowledgement from the permit holder and/or representatives that he/she has read and understands the TERMS & CONDITIONS and undertakings contained herein and further that he/she has the authority to represent and bind the licensee on all matters pertaining to this permit

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR ALL FIELDS, DIAMONDS & SPORT COURTS

- To comply and to cause those using the facilities under this permit to comply with all of the terms and conditions of this permit;
- To inspect the premises and facilities covered by this permit prior to any use by the permit holder to ensure that the facilities are suitable for the permit holder's intended use;
- That all Park Board premises and facilities are accepted "as is" and are used entirely at the permit holder's own risk. .
- The Vancouver Park Board is publicly funded and the use of parks and facilities must reflect this fact. Users must comply with all applicable City by-laws and Federal and Provincial legislation, including the British Columbia Human Rights Code which prohibits discriminatory conduct including conduct that would expose persons or groups to hatred
- The City of Vancouver and the Vancouver Park Board reserve the right to cancel an activity for any reason and shall not be responsible for any associated costs or damages.

THE LICENSEE AND THEIR REPRESENTATIVES NAMED ON THIS PERMIT ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- Ensuring the assigned area is appropriate for the activity.
- Ensuring the activity is conducted in a safe and orderly manner.
- Ensuring the activity is restricted to the assigned area.
- Ensuring that event activities do not interfere with other park users.
- Ensuring the Play Fields, Parks and Change Rooms are left clean and litter free.

PERMIT HOLDERS WILL BE BILLED BY THE VANCOUVER PARK BOARD FOR ANY ASSOCIATED COSTS RELATED TO ADDITIONAL CLEAN UP.

- Property damage occurring during permitted time, set-up or take down.
- DAMAGES WILL BE ASSESSED AND REPAIR COSTS BILLED TO THE LICENSEE
- Consulting with the Vancouver Police Department and the City Engineering Department if traffic control is required
- Using paper or plastic cups for beverages, glass containers are not permitted.
- Ensuring light boxes are turned off when not in use.
- Change Rooms are kept locked when vacant.

Ensuring ONLY NON TOXIC SPORTS FIELD WHITING is used to line/mark Park Board grass/gravel fields and diamonds. ARTIFICIAL TURF FIELDS CANNOT BE LINED BY ANY MEANS.

- Barbeques may be used provided they are thirty (30) inches from the ground, but not above or on asphalt, concrete, playing fields, diamonds or picnic tables.
- Coals are to be taken off site or placed in hot coal disposal pits.
- It is strongly recommended that slo-pitch teams use Core 44 Softballs on diamonds with outfields under 300 feet and Core 40 Softballs on diamonds with outfields under 275 feet.

UNDERSTANDING THAT PLAY UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS SHOULD NOT OCCUR:

- Any element exists which could jeopardize the safety of participants.
- A Field Closure is in effect
- During and after periods of heavy rainfall or when the field is already water saturated.
- Standing water is present (anywhere on the field) or muddy patches are present.
- The playing surface is frozen (Frost or Snow)
- Field remediation costs for playing under the above conditions will be assessed and billed to the licensee.

PAYMENT, INSURANCE, REFUNDS & CANCELLATIONS

PAYMENT:

Permits will not be released until full payment is made
Requests will be deleted if payment is not made 10 working days prior to the 1st event listed on a permit.

INSURANCE:

The licensee must obtain comprehensive General Liability Insurance protecting the City of Vancouver, Vancouver Board of Parks and Recreation, and the Vancouver Police Board against liability for bodily injury, death or property damage arising out of the activity.

The Vancouver Park Board requires a copy of proof of insurance 10 working days prior to the 1st event listed on this permit.

Permits will not be released until proof of insurance is received by the Vancouver Park Board authorized agents.

The Vancouver Park Board requires a minimum of \$2,000,000 Commercial General Liability Insurance on any permits which are more than 1 date or over 4 hours in duration.

The maximum deductible must be no more than \$5,000.00 per occurrence, with a cross liability clause naming the City of Vancouver, Vancouver Board of Parks and Recreation and the Vancouver Police Board as "additional insureds" with respect to liability arising out of permitted activities and events.

The foregoing are minimum insurance requirements required by the City of Vancouver & Vancouver Park Board.

The City of Vancouver does not warrant that this insurance is adequate for the licensee's needs.

By accepting this permit, the licensee acknowledges sole responsibility, at its own cost, any insurance required by law or deemed necessary to protect its interest.

REFUNDS & CANCELLATIONS:

Once a permit has been confirmed, a minimum notice of 10 working days prior to the requested date cancelled is required to receive a refund.

Permit requests created and confirmed within the 10 working day period will not be eligible for a refund.

The City of Vancouver and the Vancouver Park Board reserves the right to cancel an activity for any reason and shall not be responsible for any associated costs or damages. Refunds will be issued for these cancellations with no administration fee attached.

Vancouver's parks and beaches will be smoke-free effective September 1, 2010.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS: The following "Terms and Conditions" are incorporated into and form part of this permit agreement.

1. The licensee is responsible for ensuring that: the assigned area is appropriate for the activity; the activity is conducted in a safe, orderly manner; the activity is restricted to the assigned area; the event/activities do not interfere with other park users.
2. Any property damage which occurs during the permitted activity, set-up or take down, is the responsibility of the licensee. Damage to park property should be reported immediately. It will be assessed and repair costs billed to the licensee.
3. The licensee is responsible for leaving the area clean and litter free and may be billed for any subsequent cost incurred by the Board for clean-up.
4. If traffic control is required, the Vancouver Police Department and the City Engineering Department must be consulted.
5. Barbeques may be used provided they are thirty (30) inches from the ground, but not above or on asphalt, concrete or picnic tables. Coals are to be taken off site or placed in hot coal disposal pits.
6. Only paper or plastic cups may be used for beverages. For safety reason, no glass container are permitted.
7. The City of Vancouver reserves the right to cancel an activity for any reason and shall not be responsible for any associated costs or damages.

UNLESS SPECIFIED AS A CONDITION OF USE:

"The permittee/licensee must obtain Commercial General Liability Insurance protecting the City of Vancouver, Vancouver Board of Parks and Recreation and the Vancouver Police Board against third party claims for bodily injury, death or property damage arising out of the activities conducted by or behalf of the permittee/licensee. The minimum limits shall be \$2,000,000 inclusive per occurrence with a deductible no greater than \$5,000. The policy shall contain a cross liability clause and name the City of Vancouver, Vancouver Board of Parks and Recreation and the Vancouver Police Board as "additional insureds" with respect to liability arising out of the Event. Satisfactory evidence of insurance must be received by the Board of Parks and Recreation prior to use of any facilities covered under this permit.
